

Frequently Asked Questions

Do you have to attend all days of auditions?

No. You must only attend the Cattle Call audition to be in the show. However, you must attend any call backs if you wish to be considered for a part. If you are not asked for a call back, you are automatically in the chorus for the show. No further audition is required.

If I do not get a call back, am I cut from the show?

No. We do not do any cuts. It may mean that you are not being considered for a main or supporting role or you indicated that you are not interested in a main or supporting role.

Do I have to stay for the whole audition time each day?

Yes. We expect that everyone stays for the duration of the audition. If we get finished with the cattle call at a decent time, we may move right on into call backs. Also, we may need to have a candidate go opposite another character that auditions later in the day.

Do you have to be in chorus during the school day to be in the musical?

No. It is open to anyone at Hilton High School. However, it is strongly encouraged that you do so. This is the principal time for you to get individualized attention to your singing instrument which will aid in your successful acquisition of a role.

Can I be in a sport/dance/marching band etc. and be in musical?

Yes. However, we expect that you will be fully committed to the rehearsals for this show. Being a good manager of your time is a life lesson and this is one of those opportunities for you to work on this. If you have further questions please contact Mr. Klock at aklock@hilton.k12.ny.us

Will being in another activity outside of musical hinder my chances at getting a lead role?

Yes it can. We cannot give a leading role to someone who is not going to be at the vast majority of the rehearsals despite how they audition. Reasonable considerations will be made, but they are up to the discretion of the director.

Do I have to be memorized for the audition or call backs?

No. However, it is highly encouraged.

Will there be a dance audition in June?

No. Any dance auditions will be held in the fall.
